Common Tempo Markings

Tempo, or "time" in Italian, is the speed or pace a piece of music is to be played, as measured in beats per minute, but also expressing mood. In classical music, composers customarily marked the tempo by one or more Italian words. This was because many of the most important composers of the 17th century were Italian, and it was during this period that tempo markings were developed and standardized. Even after the invention of the metronome in the early 1800's, musicians continued to use the Italian tempo markings, since they indicated both mood and speed. Some of the most common tempos in classical music include the following:


Allegro - fast and bright or "march tempo" (120-168 bpm), i.e. George Frideric Handel's *Messiah—Hallelujah Chorus*

Moderato - moderately (108-120 bpm), i.e. Felix Mendelssohn's *Wedding March*

Andante - at a "walking" pace (76-108 bpm), i.e. Brahm's Lullaby

Adagio - slow and stately or "at ease" (66-76 bpm), i.e. Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata or Dvorak's New World Symphony

Fermata - "stopped" or prolonged beyond the normal duration of the note value, per the discretion of the conductor, but usually twice as long



Vivace - "lively and fast" (168-176 bpm), i.e. Rimsky-Korsakov's *Flight of the Bumble Bee*
