### The Power of Music

In 2015, Professor Susan Hallam MBE was commissioned by the Music Education Council to write a book reviewing and synthesizing research on the impact of actively engaging in making music on the intellectual, social and personal development of children and young people. Key conclusions from her book, *The Power of Music*, are as follows.

Recent review of evidence from neuroscience suggests that actively making music can contribute to the enhancement of a range of non-musical skills and lead to many other beneficial motivation in education
